## **RESOLUTION 23-02**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Chapter 72 Section 05 of the Murray Code of Ordinances Traffic Code, the Murray Governing Body may place stop signs or other signs, signals, standards, or mechanical devices in any street or alley under the municipality's jurisdiction for the purpose of regulating or prohibiting traffic thereon; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Murray to install stop signs on How Avenue at the intersection of W Young Street, both on the right corner of northbound How Avenue and the right corner of southbound How Avenue, to be in effect continually; and

**WHEREAS**, the intersection of How Avenue and W Young Street will become a four-way stop intersection, as W Young Street has stop signs for eastbound and westbound traffic;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Chairperson and Board of Trustees of the Village of Murray, Nebraska, have declared that the intersection of How Avenue and W Young Street will have stop signs placed in such a manner as to stop traffic on the northbound and southbound way of travel, making this intersection a four-way stop intersection, effective and in force continually upon the passage of this resolution.
